Post entries add \$5 per class

Entries close 5 classes before actual class

Classes: \$15 entry fee all NASMA Classes
\$10 entry fee all Non-NASMA Open Classes
\$25 entry fee for \$250 Walk-trot Classes
Less than 10 entries, 70% payback
Entries in loping classes may compete

\$75 show all day for Youth & Amateurs in their respective classes

NASMA FEE: \$2.00 per animal
Office fee of \$5/day per animal

No Overnight Tie-Outs Anywhere on Grounds. A fee of \$20/equine/day for day use Tie-Outs will be required.

Stalls \$65 Friday - Saturday night Includes 1 bag of shavings

- Additional nights—\$30 per night
- Additional bags of shavings \$8 per bag

Camping:

- \$45 for the weekend—water and/or electric
- \$ 20 primitive camping

NASMA membership **NOT** required **EXCEPT** in Amateur classes. Amateur exhibitors must present current NASMA amateur card and show a NASMA registered animal in their name or immediate family member's name.

All junior mules must have mouthing certificates

Current Coggins and 30-day health papers required for all out of state participants.
